

NORTH POLE RADIO NEWS - TRANSCRIPT

Elf Holly Berry: Greetings! I'm Elf Holly Berry reporting from the Special Assignment Desk for North Pole Radio News. Santa Claus has assembled a high-powered team of elves to oversee the crisis management of the situation in Santa's Workshop. For those of you new to this story, as of today, the team announced that Santa's workshop is approximately 141 days behind schedule with just 89 days left until Santa launches. Joining us from North Pole Flight Command to take a few questions about the road ahead for this crisis team and, indeed, for the entire North Pole, is Elf Roger Star. Elf Holly Berry: This sounds very complicated. So if you're involved at Flight Command, I would assume this is likewise disrupting the schedule for other departments.

Elf Roger: It is and there are many elves and even reindeer who are involved.

Elf Holly: Reindeer? How are Santa's reindeer affected?

Elf Roger: We're moving more things at different times and from different places. We're not only going to need special transport sleighs to assist with that but also reindeer to pull those sleighs. I would say every department at the North Pole will be affected and elves of all types, not just workshop elves, will be under some added pressures as we work this problem.
