

NORTH POLE RADIO NEWS - TRANSCRIPT

Elf Frank Myrrh: Hello once again from the North Pole News Desk, I'm Elf Frank Myrrh of North Pole Radio News. Frank, did you know that the GPS system on the sleigh is able to track data in real time as it is entered into Santa's World Map at SantaTrackers.net?

Elf Crash: You know how Santa issues the bedtime advisories right on his sleigh as he travels the world and it instantly shows up on the North Pole Flight Command website? That same technology updates the heads-up display screen on Santa's sleigh instantly as people add their information to the Santa Map. I watched it work today on a prototype and it's about the coolest thing I've ever seen. They are using that same technology to bridge messages sent from SantaUpdate.com – all of them, Frank – the texts for Santa, the emails, the wish lists, the delivery notifications – all of it Santa will be able to see instantly as it is submitted to the website.

Elf Frank: Crash, is there no end to the geeky stuff you like? When will it ever be perfect for you?

Elf Crash: It'll be perfect, Frank, when they can teleport actual eggnog and real tacos direct to my sleigh. That's when my geeky dreams will be fulfilled.
